

Privacy Notice

This privacy notice outlines how and why the **Hintalovon Child Rights Foundation** (registered office: Jurányi utca 1., 1027 Budapest, Hungary; reg. number: 01-01-0012255; Municipal Court of Budapest 16.Pk.60139/2016/4; hereinafter “**us**”, “**our**” and “**we**”) collects, uses, and stores your personal data, and your rights in relation to the personal data we hold. Purpose of processing and categories of personal data

We will process the following personal data for the following purpose(s):

The ChiLLS (Children in Legal Language Settings) Conference – ONLINE EVENT on Monday 19 October and Tuesday 20 October 2020

All presentations of the Conference will be digitally recorded as well as the slides from the online presenters. During the presentations, participants will not have the opportunity to ask questions orally, but it will be possible to type their questions into a chat panel.

The Conference will be in sync with all the laws of the relevant jurisdiction, including GDPR, and the use of data collected on our behalf will be treated appropriately.

Types of personal data we process

- **Identification data**, such as name, place and date of birth, and other identification documents.
- **Contact details**, such as address, e-mail address and telephone number(s).
- **Job related information**, such as profession, workplace.

Transfer of personal data

Commissioned processing

For the processing of your personal data, we will to some extent use specialized service contractors, who will act as our data processors. Such service contractors will be carefully selected and regularly monitored by us. They will only process personal data in accordance with our instructions and on the basis of an appropriate data processing agreement.

Transfer to third parties

We will share your personal data with the following third parties for the following purpose:

Third parties: KU LEUVEN (Katholieke Universiteit Leuven: Oude Markt 13, 3000 Leuven, Belgium) and University of Bologna (Università di Bologna: via Zamboni 33, 40126 Bologna, Italy)

Scope and purpose of transfer: We will collect information about you in connection with your registration for the Conference, which requires your consent to process your personal data. The data will be used for reporting purposes to the aforementioned third parties and will not be used for any other purpose. You will only be contacted in the framework of this Conference. Whether you consent to our processing your personal data is voluntary. However, if you do not give your consent, we cannot allow you to participate in the Conference.

You may change or withdraw your consent at any time. Depending on how you wish to change or withdraw your consent, this may result in the agreements made between you and us not being able to be fulfilled. If you request to change or withdraw your consent, we will inform you

of the possible consequences of that. You cannot withdraw consent retrospectively. If you wish to change or withdraw your consent, please contact us as info@hintalovon.hu.

Retention period

Personal data collected through the application/registration process will be stored for a period of one year following the Conference.

Information regarding your rights

- Right to object to processing for reasons of our own legitimate interest, public interest, or profiling, unless we are able to prove that compelling, warranted reasons superseding your interests, rights, and freedom exist, or that such processing is done for purposes of the assertion, exercise, or defense of legal claims.
- Right to data portability.
- Right to file a complaint with a data protection authority.
- You may at any time with future effect revoke your consent to the collection, processing, and use of your personal data. For further information, please refer to the passages above describing the processing of data based on your consent.

You are not obliged to provide your personal data. In case you do not provide your personal data, this will not adversely affect you.
